

EN: DIY Beaded Easter Egg instructions

1. Cord

- Cut approx. 3 m of cord.

2. Prepare the egg

- Tie the cord to the eye screw.
- Glue the eye screw into the top of the egg and press the cord into the glue.
- Let the glue dry while threading beads onto the cord (approx. ½ m. at a time).

3. Cover the egg

- Apply glue and wrap the beaded cord tightly around the egg.
- Continue until the egg is fully covered.

4. Finish

- Glue the bottom and create the final row of beads.
- Tuck the cord end under the last rows and tighten until the glue sets.
- Cut off the excess cord.
- Cut a hanging cord to the desired length and attach it to the eye screw.
